Prestigious fellowships are nationally competitive merit-based awards providing funding opportunities to help students realize their goals. There are fellowships to fund study abroad; to fund professional development opportunities; to engage in the arts; to fund graduate school; and to do research. Applying for prestigious fellowships also creates an opportunity for self-reflection and critical thinking skill building.

Fellowships in Business Administration

There are many competitive fellowships that align with the goals of graduate students in business. Examples are listed on the back. Students should particularly seek fellowships that offer professional development experiences within the sectors that they intend to build careers.

Fellows are placed as technologists in federal, state or local governments.
