Prestigious fellowships are nationally competitive merit-based awards providing funding opportunities to help students realize their goals. There are fellowships to fund study abroad; to fund professional development opportunities; to pursue internships; to fund graduate school; and to do research. Applying for prestigious fellowships also creates an opportunity for self-reflection and critical thinking skill building.

Fellowships in Computer Science & Technology

There are many competitive fellowships that align with the goals of Computer Science & Technology majors. Examples are listed on the back. Students should particularly seek fellowships that fund study abroad, professional experiences, and graduate study.

Fellows will work at public interest organizations at the forefront of debates on tech policy issues or public affairs consultancies with expertise in the policy strategy space.

Offers students interested in journalism and technology the opportunity to spend the summer working at relevant organizations across the world to gain valuable experience and make lifelong contacts and friends. Fellows receive a stipend and a travel budget during the 10-week program. Available in the U.S., U.K., South Korea, Germany, Australia, Denmark, Finland, Sweden, Norway, and Ireland.

NYU Cyber Fellows earn a Cybersecurity Master's degree and receive scholarships that cover roughly 75% of tuition for US residents, and as a part-time program, that offers much of the course work online.

Grants for U.S. citizens to pursue overseas graduate study, to serve as an English Teaching Assistant (ETA), or to conduct independent research projects.
