Harry S. Truman Scholarship

Graduate school funding for eligible juniors pursuing careers as public service leaders. Truman aims to pick out people with the potential to envision positive change and then provide support to help them realize their aspirations. Truman scholars, in time, aspire to improve the ways that public agencies serve society. www.truman.gov

Public Policy and International Affairs (PPIA) Fellowship

A fully funded 7-week summer program offering rigorous academic graduate-level preparation and leadership development for juniors committed to public service careers. National Science Foundation Research Experiences for Undergraduates (REU)

Provides funding for summer or semester long research participation by undergraduate students in any of the areas of research funded by the National Science Foundation. REU projects involve students in meaningful ways in ongoing research programs or in research projects specifically designed for the REU program. Many opportunities available in Psychology research.

Knight-Hennessy Scholars

Each year a group of high-achieving students from around the world with demonstrated leadership and civic commitment, from a wide array of backgrounds, will receive funding for 3 years to pursue a graduate education at Stanford University in any discipline. Their academic experience will focus on both subject-specific knowledge and leadership development.

Samvid Scholars

Supports up to \$50,000 per year for two years of graduate study. In addition to funding for their graduate program, each Scholar will also receive two years of leadership development programming. Open to US Citizens and DACA Recipients. Graduate programs that are eligible for the program include: MD, MBA, JD, MPP/MPA, MPH, MS/MA in the social sciences or STEM.

Paul and Daisy Soros Fellowship for New Americans

Provides funding for graduate study in any field at any advanced degree-granting institution in the United States. Each award could total of as much as \$90,000. Applicants must be a New American (a green card holder or naturalized citizen if born abroad; a child of naturalized citizens if born in this country).

National Science Foundation Graduate Research Fellowship

NSF GRF awards are for students in NSF-supported STEM disciplines who are pursuing research-based master's and doctoral degrees at accredited US institutions. Donald M. Payne International Development Fellowship

Provides graduate school funding for two-year programs in fields relevant to international development to recent graduates committed to becoming USAID Foreign Service Officers. Also provides two summer internships, offers mentoring from a USAID FSO, and other professional development activities.

Provides full funding to complete a postgraduate level degree at Oxford University in any field. Rhodes Scholars are chosen not only for their outstanding scholarly achievements, but for their character, commitment to others and to the common good, and potential for leadership in their chosen career. Open to nationals of any country.

Gates Cambridge Scholarships

They are awarded to outstanding applicants from countries outside the UK to pursue a full-time postgraduate degree in any subject available at the University of Cambridge. www.gatescambridge.org/

The American-Scandinavian Foundation Fellowships

Fellowships and grants to individuals to pursue research or study in one or more Scandinavian country for up to one year. The number of awards varies each year according to total funds available. Awards are made in all fields.

Chevening Scholarships

Offered in 118 countries (excluding the USA and the EU) to student from around the world to study postgraduate courses at universities in the UK. Provides full or part funding for full-time courses at postgraduate level, normally a one-year Master's degree, in any subject and at any UK university.

Marshall Scholarships

Full funding for Americans of high ability to study for a graduate degree in any field and at any university in the United Kingdom. The award covers tuition and fees, personal travel, book allowances, and provides a living stipend. www.marshallscholarship.org/

German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD)

Scholarship for a year of independent study/research or a master's degree program at a German university. Applicants in the humanities and social sciences should have a good command of German.

Fulbright U.S. Student Program

Funding for graduate study, to conduct research, and to teach English worldwide. The program facilitates cultural exchange through direct interaction on an individual basis in the classroom, field, home, and in routine tasks, allowing the grantee to gain an appreciation of others' viewpoints and beliefs.

Up to twelve Mitchell Scholars between the ages of 18 and 30 are chosen annually for one year of postgraduate study in any discipline offered by institutions of higher learning in Ireland and Northern Ireland.

Awards to students pursuing an Erasmus Mundus Joint Graduate Degree Program at two or more universities in the European Union. Many masters and doctoral programs to choose from and Candidates of all nationalities are eligible for Erasmus degree programs and scholarships.
