Prestigious fellowships are nationally competitive merit-based awards providing funding opportunities to help students realize their goals. There are fellowships to fund study abroad; to fund professional development opportunities; to pursue internships; to fund graduate school; and to do research. Applying for prestigious fellowships also creates an opportunity for self-reflection and critical thinking skill building.

Fellowships in Journalism and Media Studies

There are many fellowships that align with the goals of Journalism majors. Journalism and Media Studies students should particularly seek fellowships that fund study abroad, cultural exchange programs, professional development experiences and graduate study.
