Benjamin A. Gilman International Scholarship

International study is intended to better prepare U.S. students to assume significant roles in an increasingly global economy and interdependent world. With this goal in mind, Gilman annually offers 2,300 scholarships of up to \$5,000 for study abroad during winter, summer, or fall/spring semesters.

Opportunities to study abroad in areas of the world that are critical to U.S. interests and underrepresented in study abroad. The program focuses on geographic areas, languages, and fields of study deemed critical to U.S. national security.

Freeman-ASIA (Freeman Awards for Study in Asia)

Designed to support U.S.-based undergraduates with demonstrated financial need who are planning to study overseas in East or Southeast Asia. The program's goal is to increase the number of U.S. citizens and permanent residents with first-hand exposure to and understanding of Asia and its peoples and cultures.

Funding for graduate study, to conduct research, and to teach English worldwide. The program facilitates cultural exchange through direct interaction on an individual basis in the classroom, field, home, and in routine tasks, allowing the grantee to gain an appreciation of others' viewpoints and beliefs.

Recognizes and fosters intellectual achievement, leadership, and a commitment to community and public service. Up to twelve Mitchell Scholars between the ages of 18 and 30 are chosen annually for one year of postgraduate study in any discipline offered by institutions of higher learning in Ireland and Northern Ireland.
