



What are Prestigious Fellowships?

Prestigious fellowships are nationally competitive merit-based awards providing funding opportunities to help students realize their goals. There are fellowships to fund study abroad; to fund professional development opportunities; to engage in the arts; to fund graduate school; and to do research. Applying for prestigious fellowships also creates an opportunity for self-reflection and critical thinking skill building.

Fellowships to Work Abroad

There are many competitive fellowships that provide funding to work abroad, or to pursue studies in international business. Examples are listed on the back. Candidates should particularly seek fellowships that fund study abroad, overseas internships, and those offering professional development experiences.

Participants spend a year studying and working while completely immersed in German culture. Covers 2 months German language training, semester of study at a German university, 5 month internship with a German company.

Provides 3 summer internships to promising undergraduate students from NYC partner colleges. *One summer internship must be overseas.* Fellows widen their view of the workplace and deepen their experience in fields of interest.

AIF Banyan Impact Fellowship in India

Funds and places for 10-months young professionals from the US in service with communities and organizations across India for mutual learning, capacity building, and leadership development in support of social justice. Fellows work on projects closely linked to Sustainable Development Goals and create sustainable impact through service and fieldwork.
