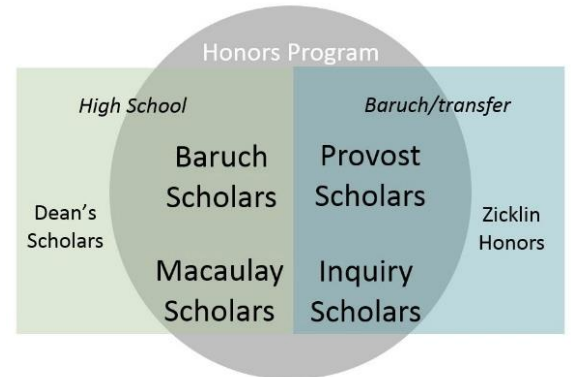


Leadership and Service
